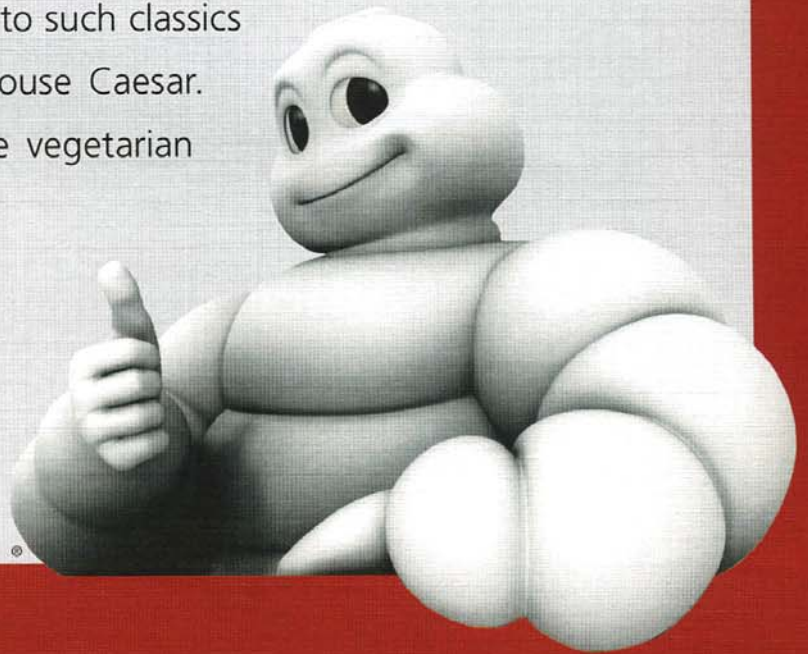

Cole's Chop House

Steakhouse 

An original open truss ceiling and Douglas fir floors attest to the history of the 1886 hand-hewn stone building now home to Cole's Chop House, a classic meat-and-potatoes destination with clubby ambience and spendy cuisine: entrées top out at \$69 for a 21-day dry-aged porterhouse. But don't fret, as there are 20 plus pages of wines, including several luscious Napa Cabs, or classic and seasonal cocktails to take your mind off the bill.

Boozier pleasures aside, Greg Cole's Chop House serves an American-style menu that is dizzying for omnivores. Look for succulent Iowa pork, New Zealand lamb, and sustainable seafood in addition to such classics as oysters Rockefeller and a chophouse Caesar. Herbivores can wait at Ubuntu, the vegetarian mecca, next door.



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
