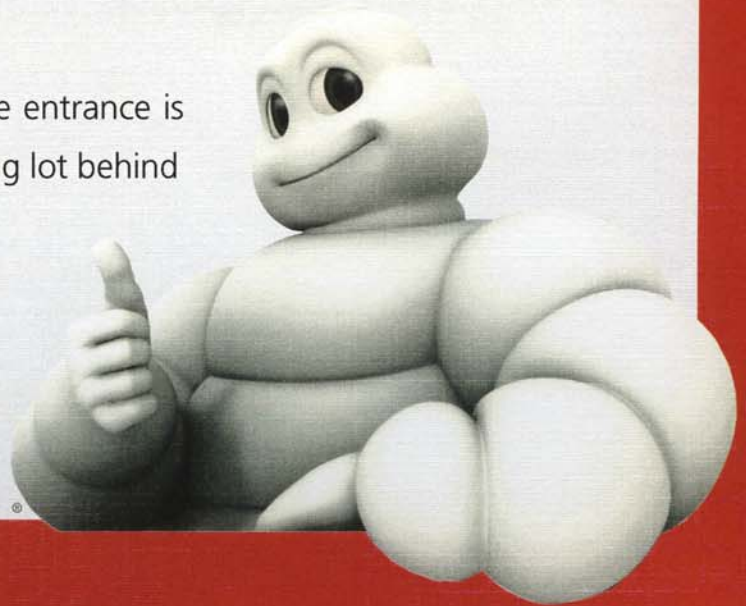
### Cole's Chop House

Steakhouse 

Down the street from sibling Celadon, Greg Cole's pricier steakhouse gives locals good reason to dress for dinner in laid-back Napa. With its soaring truss ceiling and towering hand-hewn stone walls (original to this 1886 structure), Cole's departs from the stuffy men's-club tone set by many steakhouses. A large variety of wines are displayed around the room; the sommelier may reach over your table for that luscious bottle of Napa cabernet cached overhead.

On the menu, straightforward classics like oysters Rockefeller; Caesar salad; or formula-fed veal and New Zealand lamb complement the main attraction: prime 21-day-dry-aged Angus beef.

Despite the Main Street address, the entrance is on the creek side, by the valet parking lot behind the restaurant.



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
